Getting to the venue

THE VENUE

8 Northumberland is located only a stone's throw away from Trafalgar Square, making it easily accessible via London's excellent public transport links.



TRAVELLING BY PLANE TO LONDON

Arriving into London Heathrow (LHR)

Heathrow has superb transport connections to central London to suit every passenger's budget and requirements including: Heathrow Express, [London Underground](#), Heathrow Connect, National Express Coach, Feltham Rail Link and Taxi. [Find out more here](#)

The [Heathrow Express](#) is the fastest way to reach central London. You can transfer from all Heathrow Terminals to London Paddington rail station. One way tickets cost from just £5.50 and the journey time is only 15 minutes. From Paddington you can take the [London Underground](#) to the venue (see further details below).

The cost of a Taxi from London Heathrow to central London is approximately £45–£70 and the journey time is approximately one hour.

Arriving into London Gatwick (LGW)

You can get to central London from Gatwick Airport by rail, road, taxi and car. [Find out more here.](#)

The fastest way into London is to take the [Gatwick Express](#) to London Victoria rail station. The trains run every 15 minutes and the journey time is 30 minutes. A one-way ticket costs around £20. From Victoria you can take the [London Underground](#) to the venue (see further details below).

The cost of a Taxi from London Gatwick to central London will vary depending on your destination, but will take around one hour and will cost approximately £50–£100.

Arriving into London Stansted (STN)

Travellers can get to and from London to Stansted Airport with National Express coaches, Stansted Airport Trains (Stansted Express), or by taxi and car. [Find out more here](#)

The fastest way into London is via the [Stansted Express](#). A one-way single fare costs £16.60 and the service takes just 47 minutes from the airport terminal to the heart of London. The train arrives at London's Liverpool Street Station where you can connect to the [London Underground](#) to continue your journey to the venue (see further details below).

The cost of a Taxi from London Stansted to central London will vary depending on your destination, but will take around one hour and will cost approximately £60–£100.

Arriving into London City Airport (LCY)

Central London is easy to reach by public transport from the London City Airport, with a fast Docklands Light Railway service linking to London's Underground and national rail stations.

Arriving into Luton Airport (LTN)

You can reach central London via Road, Rail, Coach or Taxi. [Find out more here](#)

The fastest option between Luton Airport and London is the Luton airport train service, with a journey time of 25 minutes and frequencies of up to 6 times an hour. A standard adult fare is £25.00. The train arrives into Kings Cross/St Pancras Rail Station where you can connect to the [London Underground](#) to continue your journey to the venue (see further details below).

TRAVELLING BY EUROSTAR

The Eurostar arrives from Paris/Brussels into London's Kings Cross/St Pancras Rail Station which is ideally situated for access in the central London:

- **By Train:** www.nationalrail.co.uk.

- **By taxi** (which will be situated outside the rail station)

The two main rail stations which are located near to the venue are:

- **Charing Cross Station:** Take the Strand Exit and walk to the venue
- **London Waterloo main station:** Waterloo is two stops on the [London Underground](#) to Charing Cross tube station where you can access the venue on foot. Alternatively you can take a bus (visit: www.tfl.gov.uk/buses). Or, you can easily walk to the venue by heading north on the Waterloo Road over the bridge towards Charing Cross station.

TRAVELLING BY CAR INTO LONDON

If you are travelling into London by car you can use [Journey Planner](#) to plan out your route to the venue which is located at: **8 NORTHUMBERLAND AVENUE, LONDON, WC2N 5BY.**

GETTING TO THE VENUE – LONDON UNDERGROUND

Depending on where you arrive into central London, the venue can be reached on the [London Underground](#) with access from the following Tube station exits:

- Charing Cross: Trafalgar Square exit
- Embankment: Embankment Place exit
- Leicester Square: Exit 1
